

Ricardo Fredes, Chilean, and his wife Gloria Bello, Mexican, have 4 children, Rodrigo, Richard, Viviana and Ian. Ricardo and Gloria studied at Rio Grande Bible Seminary in Edinburg, Texas. Ricardo served as a missionary and associate pastor in Mexico City for 4 years and then served as a youth pastor in Acapulco, Mexico, where 2 of his children were born.
